



## **VBCE Scholarship Program**

### **Requirements:**

#### **Students must:**

1. Submit a 1,000 word essay on why you think we should award you the scholarship. Tell us about yourself: your accomplishments, your dreams for the future, what you want to get out of your education.
2. Be enrolled full-time or part-time at a recognized, Canadian post-secondary college or university or be enrolled as a Canadian student within select American states that edge the Canadian border. **American universities in Washington, Montana, North Dakota, Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio, New York, Vermont, Maine and New Hampshire are eligible.**
3. Must have a Canadian citizenship. Provide a photocopy of proof of Canadian citizenship with your application.
4. Be enrolled in a first year or in a postgraduate business or finance program.
5. Be eligible for financial aid.
6. Be enrolled for a program starting in September 2017.
7. Complete an application form and submit it with their 1,000 word essay.
